Data Insights and Reporting Analyst

THE ORGANISATION

Venture Taranaki is a Council Controlled Organisation of the New Plymouth District Council, and is governed by an independent Board of Trustees. At Te Puna Umanga Venture Taranaki we are committed to fulfilling our obligations under Te Tiriti o Waitangi.

PURPOSE

The Data Insights and Reporting Analyst will lead Venture Taranaki / Te Puna Umanga (VT)'s data analysis, insights generation, and reporting functions to support evidence-based decision-making across the organisation and with external stakeholders.

This role will oversee key data collection, manage reporting cycles, and provide regional intelligence to inform strategic initiatives, while ensuring alignment with the organisation's performance framework, legislative requirements, and shareholder obligations.

Through impactful data, the analyst will communicate the organisation's and region's narrative, conveying compelling insights into Taranaki's economic landscape and supporting accountability and reporting activities.

SPECIFIC DUTIES & RESPONSIBILITIES

DATA INSIGHTS, PROJECT SUPPORT & REPORTING

- Lead data analysis and reporting initiatives, with a focus on using data to convey meaningful insights through Taranaki Trends, RI (Regional Intelligence) website, and other reporting tools.
- Manage the timely flow of reporting to district councils, central government departments, and other external stakeholders, while developing quarterly reports, including DEI *(Direct Economic Impact) metrics, to communicate VT's impact and regional trends.
- Ensure reporting templates, tools, and systems are optimised to align with VT's performance framework and strategic goals, emphasising data-driven narratives that reflect the region's strategic goals and outcomes.
- Provide research, analysis, and insights to support key projects within the teams and across the
 organisation.
- Generate custom reports and dashboards that summarise key regional and district data, creating visualisations and insights for Venture Taranaki and external stakeholders.
- Drive continuous improvement in data and reporting processes to enhance the accessibility and clarity of VT's regional intelligence and insight-driven communications.

REGIONAL INTELLIGENCE & COMMUNICATION

- Collect, analyse, and interpret data on the regional and national economy, turning insights into compelling stories relevant to regional strategies and community interests.
- Coordinate data procurement and survey efforts, producing reports that serve both internal and external stakeholders, ensuring insights are accessible and narratively engaging.
- Provide internal and external stakeholders with timely data/statistics support, including managing data requests and tailoring outputs to support effective storytelling, projects and strategic communication.
- Work across the VT teams to support regional strategy developments and key projects, providing information and data to assist with delivery and successful achievement of outcomes.
- Support VT marketing and communications to create and promote narratives that highlight the region's strengths, challenges, and opportunities through data and insights.
- Support the CRM system and database management for VT.
